

Table. Pair-wise comparison of average responses by age groups, gender, and type of insurance to questions about what worries Americans in healthcare. The scale is 1=none, 2=little, 3=somewhat, and 4=very worried. Totals were not equal to 1133 in each category because some responders chose not to answer all questions. Paired letters in a given column mean that two results were statistically different. For example, under Question 1 in the first sub-table, the 19-40 group is different from the 65+ group (pair of 'a'), the 41-65 group is different from the 65+ group (pair of 'b'). The 19-40 group and 41-65 group means are not statistically different.
